Joint training 14-15.05.2018

EU Badev Project - Preparing and conducting post-trauma Therapy training is in English.

Title of training: Art therapy and psychoanalytic approach with children / adolescents who have been victims of sexual abuse.

Description of the training: Helen Tartes-Babkina will present several case presentations on how to use therapy methods with children and adolescence who have been victims of sexual abuse. Many pictures of art work and video material will be presented. The second day will focus on the psychoanalytical case - how to intervene with severely traumatized adolescence who has also dissociative symptoms.

Educator: Helen Tartes-Babkina, psychologist (MSc); Art therapist (MSc Health Sciences); psychoanalytical psychotherapist. She has worked with children and adolescence since 2001 using art mediums. Helen Tartes-Babkina is a guest lecturer in Tallinn University.

Helen has worked for years with a victim and a victim psychotherapy for children who have been victims of sexual abuse.

Duration of training: 10 academic hours.
